- 7. Projects must be completed by **August 31, 2023** to get the grant. If I think there will be a delay, I will contact the Housing Support Manager ahead of time.
- 8. My grant will be paid only when the project is completed, the receipts from the store and the contractor and the 'after' photos are handed in, and the site has been inspected by a CCRI staff person.
- 9. For landlords: I must meet legal standards of health and safety in my rental property and a CCRI staff person may need to inspect the property. I must agree not to apply for a major-improvements rent increase based on the work carried out with this grant.
- 10. I declare that the information given in this application is true.
- 11. My grant application will be safely stored to keep my information private.
