





2025/26 Small Grants Fund (SGF) Application Form

Funding through the Community Development Branch of Municipal Relations under the Province of Manitoba are to support community development initiatives, strategies, projects and programs that address poverty related issues in Chalmers neighbourhood.

The Chalmers Community Renewal Inc. (CCRI) and Chalmers Neighbourhood Renewal Corporation (CNRC) has established a Small Grants Fund for fiscal year 2025/26 with a maximum project amount of \$2,500.

All funds must be expended on or before March 31, 2026.

To qualify for the grant, the project should:

- Reflect the program objective of community building/connecting and demonstrate community support. Examples of demonstrated community support include: letters of support from community organizations, 10 adult residents' signatures, 5 potential program participants.
- Be sponsored by local groups (not individuals) such as a school parent council, daycare centre, or resident association. The group does not need to be incorporated.
- Not to be used for capital improvements to private property unless the property has been made available, free of charge, for community use and the improvements relate to the proposed community use.

<u>Examples of eligible projects:</u> community events, neighbourhood cleanups, community gardens, art projects, etc.

<u>Eligible costs may include:</u> materials and supplies, equipment or other rentals, and honoraria for instructors.

<u>Costs NOT ELIGIBLE include:</u> stipends or honorariums for participation or contribution to ongoing wages for staffing. Project activities that solely contribute to private or individual gain are not eligible

Approved projects will be required to submit an itemized list of expenditures with receipts or statements of expenses for all goods and services purchased at the conclusion of the project.
